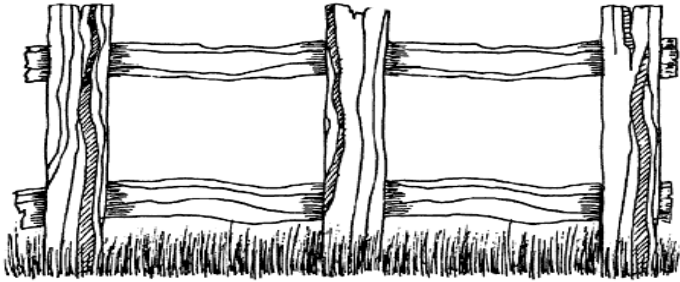

Oh, and we do not want to forget the smallest members of the family, pets Bella and Luna!!

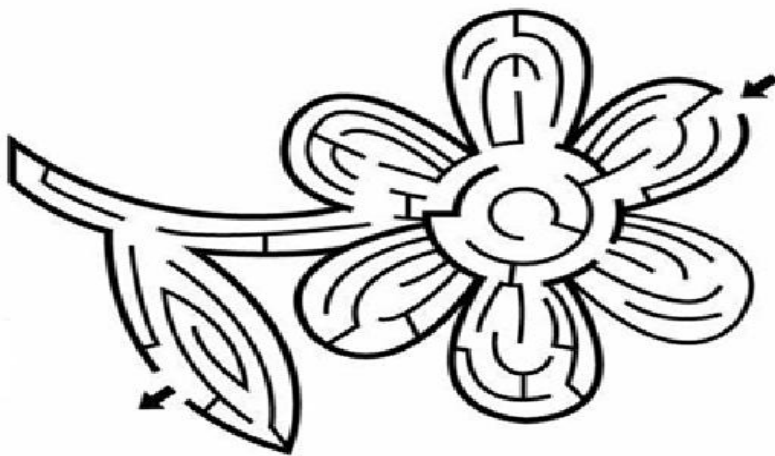
