Cedar Rail Family Campground Pet Policy 2025

Cedar Rail Family Campground welcomes campers who enjoy traveling and sharing their camping experience with their family pets. <u>Limit of two dogs per</u> site.

- 1. Aggressive dogs of any breed are not welcome at Cedar Rail Family Campground. If your dog shows behaviour that is protective and unfriendly to strangers or other dogs, please leave it at home. If you do decide to bring an aggressive dog, it must wear a muzzle for the protection of fellow campers and their pets. Failure to comply with this policy will force us to ask you to find other camping accommodations.
- 2. All dogs are required to be under the control and visual observation of their owners at all times. A 6' (six foot) leash rule is in effect whenever the animal is outside the owner's camping trailer, vehicle, cottage or motorhome. No dog should be left tied up and unattended outside the owner's camping equipment. As well, do not leave your pet locked up inside your camper if you are going to be away.
- 3. Allowing your dog to bark uncontrollably day or night will not be permitted. If you are not able to control your pet's barking behaviour, you will be asked to leave your pet at home or make arrangements at a kennel.
- 4. Your pets must be walked by a responsible person who must clean up after them.
- 5. Service dogs of any breed are welcome at Cedar Rail Family Campground, however these animals may not exhibit aggressive behaviour.
- 6. If your pet is tied outside, you must ensure that your pet cannot go past your site boundries.
- 7. You must clean up after your pet on your site as well as when you are walking your pet.
- 8. Rules posted at Dog Park must be followed or you will be asked to leave the Dog Park.
- 9. Except for service animals, no pets should be allowed in any building, inside the pool enclosure or in the pond.
