Garbage Regulations 2026



IMPORTANT RULES

Do NOT bring garbage or recycling from home. Dispose of it at your primary residence. Anyone caught bringing outside garbage into the campground will lose garbage privileges.

Only household waste generated within the campground is permitted.

GENERAL DISPOSAL

Garbage and recycling do NOT need to be sorted.

All waste must be placed in clear bags only.

Bags must be securely tied.

Do NOT use ripped or damaged bags.

Seasonal campers are responsible for disposing of their garbage in the designated dumpsters.

SPECIAL DISPOSAL INSTRUCTIONS

Cardboard: Must be kept separate, flattened, & placed in the cardboard dumpster.

Fire Pit Ashes: Place in a clear bag or sturdy box that can handle the weight.

Wood: Stack neatly at the end of your site and staff will collect it.

YARD WASTE PICK-UP- Leaves, Sticks, Wood, etc.

Please leave any leaves sticks, wood, etc., at the end of your site and staff will collect it.

Collected Mondays at 12:00 PM (*Tuesdays on long weekends*)

Plant and grass cuttings must be placed in biodegradable paper bags only.

No garbage is permitted in yard waste bags.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Disposal of anything except human waste is prohibited. Prohibited items include but not limited to mattresses, furniture, appliances, tires, bikes, or similar materials.

You will have to look after these things yourself, by taking them to the Sullivan Township Dump (and mention that you are a seasonal camper at Cedar Rail Family Campground) or to your own dump where your permanent residence is.

DUMPSTER AREA RULES

Absolutely NO dumping outside or behind dumpsters.

Do NOT leave any items in the surrounding fence rows (including ashes, leaves, or clippings).

The dumpster area is under video surveillance.

Camp Management reserves the right to enforce all rules. Failure to comply may result in immediate action, including site termination.

SEASONAL DATES

No garbage drop-off or pick-up before May 1st or after October 15th.
